## About Online and School Lesson for October

Since September 15th (Wednesday), it is possible to choose between attending classes in school or online lessons. For the time being, it will be implemented again with the same system of choosing classes in school or online only. Please contact your homeroom teacher if there are any changes. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

## Sports Day

On Saturday, October 23 we will hold our annual Sports Day and below are details on how it will undertake this school year.

1. For safety and prevention measures against COVID-19, we will have a shorter sports day program this year. In addition, only the presence of parents of grade 1 and 6 are allowed.
2. After the sports day event, students are to return to their respective classroom to have school lunch together and parents do not need to prepare their lunch from home.
3. If the sports events is not possible on the 23 rd (Sat), we will notify you by activating the simultaneous mail delivery service at 5:30 in the morning of same the day. There will be a regular class with lunch and 13:00 dismissal.
4. If the sports events is cancelled on the 23 rd (Sat), it will be rescheduled on the 24th (Sun). School lunch will be served and dismissal time is $12: 45$. And if the $24^{\text {th }}$ (Sun) is cancelled it will re-scheduled on the $31^{\text {st }}$ (Sun) and dismissal time will be 12;45 after lunch.
5. On the day of the sports day, students must come to school wearing school uniform and change to P.E. clothes in school with white socks. Please remember that students are wearing navy blue socks coming to school so if they forgot to bring white socks, a new one will be given as purchased from the boutique.
6. There will be no school bus services for parents this year, and also parents are not allowed to ride the regular school bus for students.
7. Parents must check with their child regarding leaving school after the events. Kindly notify the class teacher thru communication notebook for any changes.
8. Please observe the rules and manners regarding the use of all school parking area. The primary school ground will be available also for parking.
9. All event materials used for each grade are purchased and will be deducted from students' account. Make sure to label or write names on it. Headbands used by the cheering and relay members are school property, so please wash and iron them. Please return it to each class teacher by Saturday, October 30.

## Change Over to Winter Uniforms

From October 1st the change over period from summer to winter uniforms will begin until the $16^{\text {th }}$ of the month. Be sure that students come to school with navy blue skirts or trousers, navy blue socks, and beret hats. Blazers and short sleeve shirts and blouses are optional until the $16^{\text {th }}$ but needed to be worm from the 18th. Winter smocks will also be changed so be sure that all buttons are in place and name tags are affixed with the current student's grade year.

## Halloween

On October 30, the A course students will have a Halloween party during English lessons and the B course students will have a Halloween party during one of the lessons. This school year, the school will not provide snacks and drinks for safety reasons. All students are encouraged to change into costume on the day and we ask that costume preparation not pose any undue burden. Please do not bring costumes that expose the skin and any other items that will be bulky and hard to carry to and from school. Photo Create will be in the school taking photos of the classes and some will appear in the graduation album. Please be sure not to forget your costumes.

## Bags and Belts

Black sub bags are being sold at the Maria boutique to be used by students in grade 4 and above although it should be noted that the purchase is not mandatory and the continued use of shoulder bags is perfectly acceptable. Grades 3 and under are to use shoulder bags but if these will not accommodate belongings please consult the appropriate persons about solutions. The blue lesson bags are to be used in the school for file storage and to hold items needed for lessons in other classrooms. These bags are to be hung on the hooks on the right side of student desks. If these bags have become lost please order a new one. Belts may be worn by grade 5 and 6 students with Gyosei issued buckle only.
