### **Supplementary Lessons and After-school Play**

From May 10<sup>th</sup> Tuesday, students in grade 2 and up may join the after-school play and supplementary study sessions on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays. There will be **no after-school play on rainy days**. Please refer to the newsletter for the monthly schedule because they may be cancelled due to our school events. If your child plans to play after school, we ask that the homeroom teacher be informed via the communication notebook. Your child's homeroom teacher will inform you as to whether supplementary study sessions are required. Supplementary lessons in French will be given to new/transfer students thru the recommendation of the subject teacher. Participation in supplementary classes for preparation for the English proficiency test is on a voluntary basis. Information was distributed yesterday. Details of the supplementary lessons in Math and Japanese will be given by each homeroom teacher. Only one school bus service is available for students joining the supplementary study sessions and after-school play. The bus going to **Kisarazu Station** (including stopovers) will depart at **15:35**. After-school study and play for grade 1 will begin in the second term.

### Kisarazu/Sodegaura Area Track and Field Meet

The annual track and field meet for Kisarazu/Sodegaura area is scheduled to be held on May 17<sup>th</sup> Tuesday. Representatives from 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders will be selected during the P.E. class. Families of the selected student's will be notified later for more details. Parents will not be allowed to watch the competition. In case of bad weather, it will be rescheduled on Wednesday the 8<sup>th</sup> or Tuesday the 24<sup>th</sup>.

### **About the Excursions**

At present, we are planning to have spring trips and still considering the different destinations with their availability that is suitable for every class and grade. Details will be announced as soon as they are finalized.



### 5<sup>th</sup> Graders' Camping Trip

For safety reasons concerning COVID-19, the camping trip which was scheduled for May 20<sup>th</sup> (Friday) to 21<sup>st</sup> (Saturday), will be cancelled and changed to a day trip activity on the 20th (Friday). More details will be provided to parents of the 5<sup>th</sup> graders on a separate sheet.

Regarding future camping trips, we will strive to implement them while taking into account social initiatives on the coronavirus issue.

#### P.E. Clothes

Students are instructed to take home P.E. clothes after they are worn. We ask that students keep an extra set of P.E. clothes at school. When red and white hats become visibly dirty, please take them home to be cleaned. As students use them during disasters, they should be kept in the pocket of lesson bags on the side of their desk for easy access.

### **Submission of Commuter IDs**

In case your commuter pass from the previous year has expired and you want to purchase a new one in the new academic year, you will need to submit transportation information. Commuter IDs are valid for one month from the date of issue. Please make arrangements in advance with your homeroom teacher.
