On October 7th Eiken was held. Test results and information regarding the second test will be mailed directly to test takers' homes. First part exam results will be sent to you on November 1st. The second test will be held on November 13th. Please consult your application forms for test locations. Results for the second test are expected to be sent on November 29th.

Starting this year, we encourage students to take the English Proficiency Test at least once a year. Students who have not yet taken the test this year are requested to take the English test that will be held in the 3rd semester.

Grade 6 Graduation Trip

From this year, the trip has changed to 2 nights and 3 days. We were blessed with fine weather as the students travelled around Nagasaki. On the first day, they visited the Christian sites in the Sotome area. The students were able to sing a hymn in Shitsu Church, a World Heritage Site. On the second day, they walked around the city of Nagasaki. We toured the remains and sites related to the atomic bomb. On the third day, the students ended the trip by walking around in Huis Ten Bosch.

Due to the spread of infectious disease, we had been unable to stay overnight, so it was a challenging three-day trip. However, each one of us was able to think and act in a good cooperation so that we could learn from each other without fail.

Field Trip

On October 26th (Wednesday), all students went on a field trip, to different destinations of each grade's choice. Students were able to discover and experience things that they would not normally be able to experience at school. We will continue to strive for the students' growth inside and outside the school.

Parent Teacher Interviews
