



Message for Advent

One day, St. Ignatius spoke to Xavier, who was burning with ambition. It moved Xavier a great deal, so that Xavier decided to give up all ambition. The two men set out to establish a Christian society for the expansion of God's Kingdom. Xavier studied theology and eventually, at Ignatius' request, set out on a missionary journey to the Orient. Leaving Lisbon, Portugal, the ship sailed through a storm and eventually arrived in India six months later. From there, he went to Malaya, where he met a Japanese man named Yajiro and set out for Japan. He landed in Kagoshima, then went on to Nagasaki and Kyoto as a missionary. Xavier reported to Ignatius in writing that his impression of the Japanese people was that they were very industrious, polite, and not ashamed of their poverty. Ignatius thanked Xavier for his missionary work in the East, but Xavier died on his way home.

We may celebrate Christmas in splendor with illuminations, but at the root of all this is the image of Christ, who was born into a poor stable. It is the poor and pure heart of Christ. External happiness does not produce happiness. The message of Christmas is to live with a pure heart and compassion like an infant.
