Funeral for Fr. Tagawa

On the afternoon of the 12th, Fr. Tagawa completed his mission on earth and returned to heaven, and on the 17th, a funeral Mass and farewell ceremony were held at the school's chapel, with about 100 sorrowful attendees and all the junior and senior high school students lining the school sidewalks and courtyard.

The following is an excerpt from the sermon given by Fr. Kato during the funeral Mass.

O God, you have taken from us the most precious person of all. Fr. Shigeru Tagawa of Gyosei International School has returned to heaven. Is this also God's grace? We are only sorry. In the past, Fr. Tagawa was hospitalized many times, maybe five or six times. Each time, surprisingly, he returned to us while we were anxious about him. This time, however, it was different. He was transferred from Kimitsu Central Hospital to St. Marianna University Hospital in Kawasaki. And then he died. We thought, "This should not be the last time. We

want you to stand up and make the heart of the school strong. We want you to make the heart of the school steadfast. We wanted you to show your determination that the school would walk forward with the desire to become a dawn star in their hearts. Gyosei is a star shining at dawn. People wait for the dawn while it is still dark at night. The day breaks in the twilight. It must be the star that shows the dawn. Those who are in this school will have to be the stars that show the dawn. Each small star becomes tens of thousands of stars before it. They gather together to become the radiance of a big star. All of us find our path in the radiance of the great star. That radiance is God's gracious mercy, warmth, generosity, gentle light, and dazzling light. It is a heart that gazes into God's wonders, a heart that accepts all events. Each of us has to nurture the wonder of dawn stars in our hearts and keeps it burning in our minds.

Fr. Dominic Tagawa Shigeru, please watch over us in Heaven. May Gyosei International School become a star of the dawn! May everyone who works hard at this school feel your spirit."

Report Cards

The purpose of report cards is to inform households of their child's progress in all aspects of school life. The information is to be used in a positive way to help students strive for self-improvement. Grade 1 report cards are graded on a three-level grading system for all subjects. In grade 2 Math, English, Japanese, and French are on a five-level grading system and from grade 3, Science and Social Studies are also included in the five-level grading system. From grade 2 to 6 Music, Art, P.E. and grade 5 and 6 Home Economics remain on the three-level grading system.5 levels are used for core subjects in higher grade levels to provide more detailed information about students' progress. Also included in the report card folders are the physical fitness test results. Please note that the name of the principal has been retained.

Summer Vacation Art craft and Science Research Homework

Being a summer vacation homework for every student in our school, students can choose either from a science research or an art craft work.

Essay Writing Contest

As part of the morning reading and Japanese learning activities, we will hold an essay writing contest in school for all graders. The submission date for the works completed during the summer vacation is September 1st-Friday. After submission, excellent works will be selected by the faculty and staff and will be given awards.

The selection of books and writing instructions were given during the Japanese class of each grade level. We also distributed the manuscript for submission to the students. The manuscript will also be used for writing instruction in Japanese class in the future.

Start of Second Term
