After School Study and Play

From May 9 (Thursday), after school study and play for 2nd grade and above will begin. Please check the following information regarding after school study and play for this school year.

Days of the week: Tuesday, Thursday, Friday (After school study will be held regardless of the weather, Afterschool play will be cancelled in case of rain)

Time: 14:35-15:20

School bus: 15:35, bound for Kisarazu Station by way of Izushima. One service only.

(It stops only at: Izushima Fire Station, Kisarazu Sogo High School, Indian Restaurant, and Kisarazu Station)

Other:

- Some days of the week may not be available due to preparations for events, etc. Please check the monthly schedule in the "Akatsuki".
- OPlease be sure to let us know the day of your child's after-school play in the contact notebook.
- OIt may rain after school and after-school play may be cancelled. In this case, students will be dismissed from school at the regular time.
- OFrench remedial classes are available only for those students who are deemed necessary by the teacher in charge of the class. A letter will be distributed to those eligible by the end of this month.
- OHomeroom teachers will inform the students of the remedial classes by letter from the homeroom teachers.
- OFirst grade after-school study and play will begin in the second semester.

Grade 5 Camping Trip

Fifth graders will go to for two days and one night from May 17 (Fri.) to 18 (Sat.) for a camping trip. They will experience a variety of programs during the two-day stay.

Kisarazu/Sodegaura Area Track and Field Meet

The Kisarazu-Sodegaura Branch Athletic Meet (Venue: Sodegaura Track & Field Stadium) is scheduled to be held on May 22 (Wed.) Representative athletes will be selected from 5th and 6th grade students in the PE class to participate. Families of the children selected as representatives will be notified of the details separately. In the event of rain, the reserve day will be May 24 (Fri.).

Uniform Change Over Period

From June, students will change into summer uniforms. Due to the high temperatures forecast for this year, the transition period will start from May 7 (Tue.), and students may come to and from school without blazers from May 7 onward. (*Trousers, skirts, socks, and hats are winter clothes*.) Please make adjustments at home judging from the weather forecast and your child's physical condition on that day.

P.E. Clothes

Students are instructed to take home their P.E. clothes after they are worn. We ask that students keep an extra set of P.E. clothes at school, so there will be no more forgotten ones. When red and white hats become visibly dirty, please get your child to take them home to be cleaned. As students use them in case of a disaster, they should be kept in the pocket of lesson bags on the side of their desk for easy access.

If the student forgets to bring his/her red and white hat, he/she will not be allowed to participate in PE. Please note that we do not lend out forgotten items.

Submission of Commuter IDs

When your child has been using a commuter pass since last year and after it expires, if you want to purchase a new one for the new school in continuous use, you are required to submit a commuter pass certificate to each transportation agency. Starting this April, students can continue to purchase a commuter pass while in school by registering their graduation date.

The commuter certificate is valid for one month from the date of issue. Please ask us to prepare a commuter certificate through your homeroom teacher well in advance. Please fill out the required information and submit it to the school, After issuance, the certificate will be given to each family.

Maria Boutique

The boutique will be closed from May 3 (Fri.) to 7 (Mon.) due to the high school mid-term break. From June, students will be wearing their summer uniform. Please place an order early if necessary as some items may take a few days to be delivered. If you need to change the size of the items purchased at Maria Boutique, kindly do it within a week after it was purchased. Please be sure to present the copy of the receipt. Please note that items without its box or tag, or items that are not the same as when they were purchased, will not be accepted for replacement.
