Dear Sir/Madam,

We are informing you about how we are going to conduct the classes from Tuesday, February 1st. As the number of infected people is on the rise nationwide, we recommend that your child should continue to attend classes online even after February 1st. However, in consideration of the circumstances of individual households, we will allow your child to come to school and attend classes in the classroom if you want him/her to do so. We would like you to think it over and inform your child's homeroom teacher of your choice by email by January 31. Basically, we would like you not to change your decision thereafter, but if you find something unavoidable to change your mind, please let us know at least one week in advance so that we can prepare lunch.

It is difficult to say how long these measures will be in effect, so we will make an announcement later.

In addition, we would like to ask for your understanding on the following points:

1. We will not be able to provide lessons for subjects that are difficult to distribute online, such as physical education.
2. In general, classes will be held from 1st to 6th period following our timetable. However, the class in the 7th period on Wednesday and the 5th period on Saturday will be cancelled.
3. Supplementary classes and after-school activities will be also cancelled.

We would like to take this opportunity to express our sincere gratitude to all the parents and guardians for your continued support in this hard situation. We pray for your safety.
