English Test

Parent-Teacher Interviews

- 6. If your child's way of going home differs from his/her usual way, please inform your child's homeroom teacher of the change by communication notebook.

Admission Tests to Our Junior High School

For our 6th grade students, our junior high school department will be giving an internal admission exam on Monday, December 1st. The tests will cover Japanese and Math. For International Course, the math test will be in English. Starting this school year, applications will be submitted online. Details will be announced in early November. All English placement test will be added afterward to the students in International Course.

Winter School Uniform

Starting Saturday, November 1, all students are to wear their blazers when coming to and leaving school. Please make sure your child does not wear winter uniform.

We find many students not wearing their school hats or not tying up their long hair.

We kindly ask parents to remind their children to be conscious of their appearance and behavior as students of our school, and to check their attire before coming to school.

During cold days, students are allowed to wear tights without socks to be worn. Wearing anything other than tights is not permitted.

While in school, students are supposed to take off their blazers. If the temperature is cold, students can wear a smock, vest or sweater. During P.E. days, students can wear their jersey. Wearing a sweater and blazers on top of P.E. uniform is not allowed. Jerseys are available at the Maria boutique for purchase.

The winter uniform long pants and jersey you have ordered are scheduled to be distributed around mid-November. If you place an order from now, it will take some time before the item can be delivered. Thank you for your understanding.
