April 8th Opening Ceremony for the 2026 School Year

The opening ceremony for the coming school year is scheduled on Wednesday, April 8th. Currently, all enrolled students are to come to school at the regular time. Students are to leave their shoes in the shoe locker and go to their classroom. After that, they will move to the gym No.2 and participate in the entrance ceremony and opening ceremony. For return, school bus departure time will be 12:30. School lunch will be served.

Please note that communication notebook will be distributed on this day.

Please be aware that textbooks will be distributed on the first day. Since there may be a large number of things to bring home, it is recommended that students come to school with their school leather bags as well.

Uniforms and School Items to Bring

Request for the publication of your child's portrait photo for publicity activities

Commuter Pass

If your commuting route will change starting in April and you are purchasing a commuter pass for the first time, you will need a school-issued commuter pass certificate. If you need a commuter pass certificate, please contact the office.

The commuter pass certificate is valid for one month. Also, because it is the start of a new academic year, certificates will be issued from April 1 onward.

Please make sure to request your commuter pass certificate well in advance, allowing enough time for processing.

Injury and Accident Mutual Aid Benefit System of the Japan Sport Council

All students at our school are enrolled in the Injury and Accident Mutual Aid Benefit System of the Japan Sport Council. If your child is injured at school and visits a doctor or hospital, the medical expenses are covered by this system. If you have not yet submitted a claim for the medical expenses, please let the school nurse know.

Request for Enrollment in Liability Insurance

There have been cases where students have accidentally broken tablets or damaged the school facilities. In such cases, parents are responsible for the repair costs. For this reason, we recommend enrolling in liability insurance.

Insurance plans such as AEON's Child Safety Insurance and Nissay's Personal Liability Plan are relatively affordable. Please use this information as a reference.
